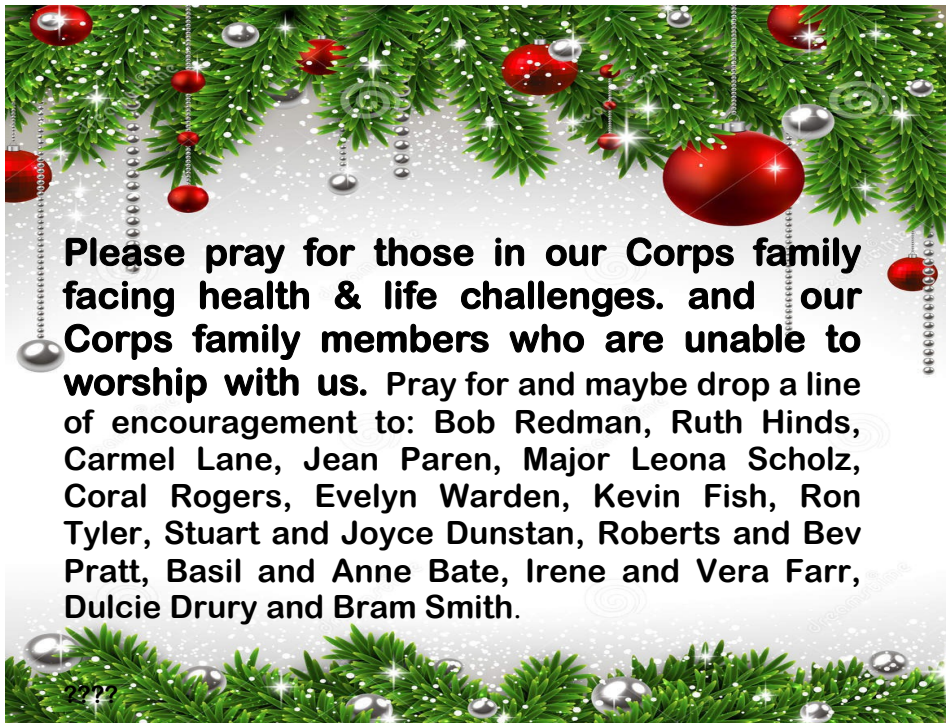

## **NEW DISASTER recovery partnership Woolworths & The Salvation Army**

The Salvation Army is delighted to announce a new national partnership with Woolworths to help us bring hope to people across Australia in times of natural disaster.

This new partnership, called S.T.A.N.D. (Support Through Australian Natural Disasters), will raise funds to help local communities get back on their feet in tough times.

Some of the proceeds will be used to support the work of Salvation Army Emergency Services (SAES) who feed and provide support for disaster survivors and the emergency services personnel who respond.



Woolworths have pledged to support us with regular donations of \$500,000 a year for five years, and will also provide opportunities for their customers to donate. Additionally Woolworths will now be selling six packs of bottled water and \$1 from every pack sold will go to support The Salvation Army.

Your corps or centre can support this initiative by purchasing these specially marked S.T.A.N.D. six packs of bottled water to use at your events for \$3.50 per pack. However if you already have local partnerships or arrangements to source bottled water in your community then please note there is no obligation for you to switch to the S.T.A.N.D. packs.

This exciting new partnership will be led by a special committee with AFL legend and 2014 Australian of the Year Adam Goodes taking on the role of Ambassador.

## Final edition of Pipeline Magazine heralds a new chapter PIPELINE SUBSCRIPTIONS

As part of the move to one National Territory, *Pipeline* - the internal magazine of the Australia Eastern Territory - is to be retired. The December issue of *Pipeline* is the final edition of the magazine. The Australia Eastern Territory editorial team has begun the transition to a new-look National Editorial Department. From that department will come a new national internal magazine, due for launch in February 2017.

This new publication will continue to carry key messages from our leaders to Salvationists and others associated with The Salvation Army across Australia. It will continue to present feature articles, stories of transformation, profiles of Salvation Army mission and ministry, opinion writing, theological pieces, culture writing, and news from corps and centres around the country.

So, what does this mean for your corps/centre subscription to *Pipeline*? Nothing! Your subscription will automatically carry over to the new national magazine. There will also be a reduction in the cover price, from \$3 (*Pipeline*) to \$2 per copy for the new magazine.
